What is The SEND Register?

All Local Authorities have a duty to maintain a central record or register of disabled children in their area under the Childcare Act 1989. Warrington's SEND Register can be found on our Local Offer website, askollie.warrington.gov.uk.

If you have a child or young person with SEND, aged birth to 25 years, you too can sign up to the SEND Register. The register will give us a clearer picture of where children with SEND live and what their needs are. This will in turn help us plan future support services more effectively.
